What To Do If You Go To The Hospital

#1

Call your kidney doctor.

Leave your name and say you are going to the hospital.

#2

Call your dialysis center.

Leave your name and say you are going to the hospital.

#3

Tell the hospital you are a dialysis patient.

Give them the name & phone number of your doctor & your dialysis center.

#4

Tell the hospital you need:

- dialysis treatments in the hospital,
- dialysis-friendly meals, and
- special care during blood draws.
